Deer Hunter –

Thank you for your interest in the City of Clinton Deer Management Program. The City of Clinton's goal is to limit the population of deer within the management zone to 20 deer per square mile.

The Clinton Deer management committee, along with the Iowa DNR, has developed a deer management plan for the City of Clinton. This year's season will run from **September 21st, 2024**, through **January 10th, 2025**.
***There has been no change in the incentive license program.**

Please fill out the enclosed application form and return it to the Parks & Recreation Department office **in person** at the **Ericksen Community Center, 1401 11th Avenue North, Clinton, Iowa**. **You must have a photo I.D. that will be photo copied when you submit your application. Applications must be returned before you can take the proficiency test.** After you return your application and passed the proficiency test if you had to take it for this year then you will receive your card to participate in the City of Clinton Deer Management Hunt and a packet with instructions and map.

You will notice that proficiency testing is **required** to obtain a city permit every other year. Please contact Dustin Krogman at the Ericksen Community Center to set up a time to take the proficiency test if you didn't take the test last year. Completion of a "Deer Harvest Report" is required within 24 hours of harvest. Complete a report at the Central Fire Station – 344 3rd Avenue North, Clinton, Iowa.
