Camp Host— will reside on site from April
15-Oct 15. The Camp Host is a repre-
sentative of the Parks & Rec Dept.
and has full authority to enforce RV
Campground rules and regulations.

ADA Accessible Camp Pads— reserved for
campers with disabilities with a valid
handicap placard displayed for ex-
clusive use until 4pm daily. At that
time, the spot may be reserved by
any camper, but they will be required
to move once another space opens
up to free up the pad.

Campers and Motor Homes must be cur-
rently registered and licensed ac-
cording to State requirements and
must be operable and/or have imme-
diate means of transportation of the
unit and kept in good repair

Guests may stay for 14 consecutive days
and must vacate the premises after the
14th day for a minimum period of 24
hours. If the campground does have
other vacancies available at the time
your 14th consecutive day period is up,
a request may be made to the Camp
Host or Staff to move to an open stall.

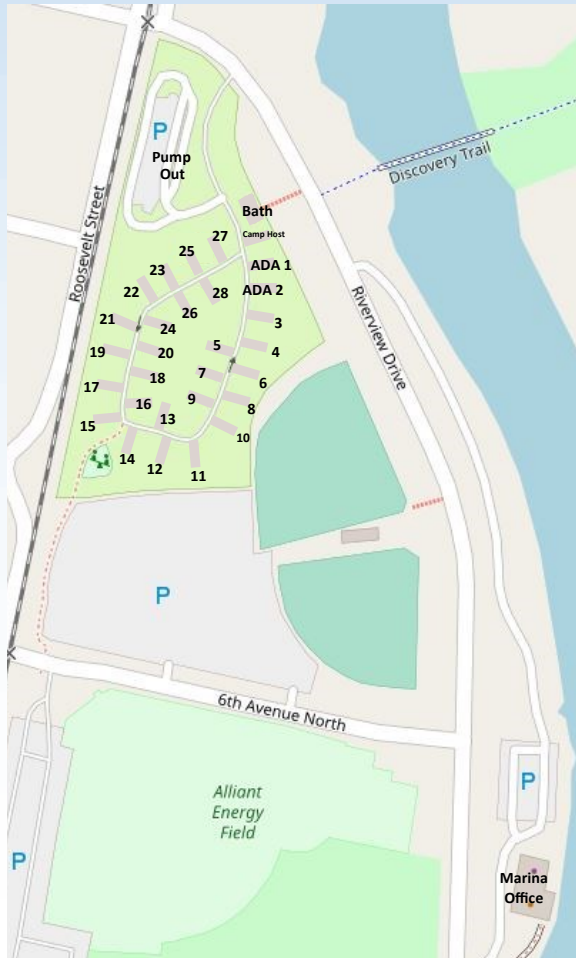

Welcome to the Riverview R/V Park
VIOLATION OF STATE, LOCAL OR FEDERAL RULES CAN
LEAD TO IMMEDIATE TERMINATION OF CAMPING
PERMIT AND ENTIRE CAMPING GROUP WILL BE ASKED
TO LEAVE PREMISES.

RULES & REGULATIONS

- ◆ Registration stub must be displayed in plain view on the dashboard of the vehicle or on the campsite post. **Daily Fee: \$22**
- ◆ **Checkout 4pm on the last night of the permit period. Day to day payments are not accepted. Length of stay is declared upon arrival along with payment.**
- ◆ One picnic table per unit is allowed
- ◆ Speed limit in the R/V Park is 5 mph
- ◆ Only registered campers are permitted in the R/V Park from 10pm—6am Quiet time 10pm—8am
- ◆ Camping in the pull through pads numbered 23, 25 and 27 shall utilized by R/V's of a min. 35 ft length.



RULES & REGULATIONS cont.

- ◆ All vehicles must fit on concrete pad in addition to the R/V. Maximum 2 vehicles. Violators may be towed. No parking on circle drive. No EXCEPTIONS Visitors may park in the overflow lot located to the north of the park.
- ◆ Fires are permitted in charcoal grills, gas grills, commercial fire pits and fire rings. Permitted times for open burning shall be from 8am until Midnight. ONLY FIREWOOD
- ◆ Campsites must be cleaned daily and waste deposited in the provided containers. Any remains from the cleaning of fish must first be wrapped in paper or placed in a plastic bag before placing in containers.
- ◆ Dogs and cats must be on a leash at all times and the leash may not exceed ten (10) feet in length and clean up all droppings and dispose of properly.
- ◆ Mowing is typically on Wednesday afternoons. All items shall be removed from the grass areas.
- ◆ Waste/grey water shall be dumped at the dumping station located to the north of the R/V Park. Any unit leaking will be asked to leave premises.
- ◆ Garbage or solid waste containers are for registered campers and for garbage or trash generated or accumulated while on the premises of the park.
- ◆ The outside use and consumption of alcoholic beverages, including beer and wine is hereby prohibited in the R/V Park between the hours of Midnight and 11am. Alcoholic beverages may only be consumed in the R/V Park by the registered camper and their guests and no person shall possess beer in containers larger than 32 oz.
- ◆ No sleeping tents, or anything flat/large like a pool or water features are allowed.
- ◆ Leaving your camper unattended for 24 hours is not permitted
- ◆ A camp site may only be secured with a RV/Camper. Use of vehicle to hold spot is not permitted
- ◆ No dishwashing allowed in drinking fountains, restrooms or water hydrants
- ◆ No ropes, cables, chains or lines may be affixed to trees or other park fixtures.

Campers Registration

Campers must register before parking and be at least 18 years of age. Registration shall be at the registration booth and campers may choose their own site, reservations are not accepted. Registration shall be complete after providing the necessary information on the registration form envelope and depositing the envelope with payment in the slot of the deposit vault located next to the registration booth.
