**SAFETY TOWN'S 2024**

A special course designed for children entering Kindergarten in the Fall 2024. The course is 5 days of learning how to be safe and becoming familiar with safety services guided by teen instructors, many of whom are Safety Town graduates themselves! Topics include crossing the street, poison, fire and stranger safety. **New - Online Registration System**

The City of Clinton Parks and Recreation will launch a NEW online registration portal (RecDesk). This system will allow registered users to reserve park shelters and other facilities, as well as register for programs, memberships and classes as they are available. The online registration system includes a secure online payment portal.

To set up your household account go to clintoniowa.recdesk.com. Start by creating the primary/head of household account. Then add your other household members. Note: for all credit card transactions, a 1.5% service fee will be charged.

If you currently have an active fitness membership, set up your account as instructed above. We will then need you to stop by the office and activate your payment in the new online system. Stay tuned for special hours for this to be completed. Then we

**SPRING YOUTH SOCCER**

Come take part in one of the area's largest youth soccer programs. This program is designed to teach the fundamentals of soccer to participants ages 3 through 8th grade.
